



Positive Discipline - Tutor Time Provision

Whilst Tutors meet with students on a 1-2-1 basis they will:

1. Review the previous week's learning
2. Check attendance
3. Check uniform
4. Check rewards
5. Check behaviour standards
6. Check parental signatures

Students will undertake the following dependent upon key stage:

KS4

Year 10 students work independently in revising for their GCSE examinations and / or completing other work.

Year 11 students are placed into Subject Classes and provided with specialist teacher input in an identified subject area. Students can move between subject areas dependent on student learning needs.

KS3

During Positive Discipline Tutor students read independently.

Research tells us the more a child reads the better they attain academically. Reading builds vocabulary, comprehension and confidence in decoding new words. These are all transferable skills and very important in helping our students succeed in a highly literate and competitive world.
