# Uniform Policy

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# Headlands School

All students in Years 7-11 are expected to wear school uniform. We look to parents to support us in maintaining good standards of dress. Wearing school uniform encourages a positive attitude to school and work. The information below describes Headlands School Uniform requirements.

Black blazer with school logo\*  
Headlands School tie in red and black stripe  
Plain, collared white shirt  
Black V-neck jumper or cardigan (optional)\*\*  
Black Trousers  
Black flat shoes  
Charcoal grey pleated skirt\*\*\*

*\*Headlands School will provide students with a free iron-on logo. Blazers **are** compulsory.*

*\*\* Students can choose to wear a V-neck jumper or cardigan with or without the Headlands School logo on it, but this is optional.*

*\*\*\*If skirts are deemed too short they must be replaced by parents/carers or black trousers must be worn.*

## Jewellery

The wearing of jewellery is restricted as in some cases it may pose a health and safety risk; in addition some jewellery may be expensive and the school cannot be held responsible for loss or damage. Consequently jewellery is limited to:

- A watch (Not a smart watch)
- A single signet ring
- Simple ear stud.

## Make up

Only discreet make up is allowed. Students cannot wear blusher, contour, eye shadow, lipstick, lip liner, eye liner, eye brow pencil or false eyelashes. Nail polish, gel, acrylic or other forms of false nails are not allowed.

Students should not dye their hair bright colours.

## Adaptations

Students have always tried to adapt the school uniform to their individual tastes, it is important that we maintain a standard uniform. The following are examples of such adaptations and are **not** allowed:

Trousers – denim, canvas, jogger, leggings

Skirts – lycra, excessively short

Shoes – trainers with logo's, stripes, boots of any kind, canvas pumps, coloured sidewalls, piping

Tights – footless or skin coloured

In addition students will often add fashion belts, large ear rings, bangles, wrist bands, beads, necklaces and a variety of hats. These are also **not allowed** - appropriate hats can be worn outside the school building when the weather is cold. Base ball style caps are **not permitted** in the school grounds.

**Technology Food** – Bib apron with large black and white check

**Resistant Materials** – Bib apron, plain beige or with school logo

**PE** - Plain red polo shirt with short sleeves Plain black shorts Plain black / plain red crew neck sweat shirt (optional) Plain black jogging / tracksuit bottoms (optional) Plain long red football socks Non marking trainers Football boots (optional) White socks for summer Plain black rugby shirt

PE Kit is compulsory even if students are not actively participating in the lesson. Please note that if playing for a school football team, School BLACK shorts and long red socks must be worn.

If parents are in any doubt, they should contact their child's Head of Year before purchasing any item.
